LEAGUE WELFARE SCHEME

The function of the welfare scheme shall be to assist those who suffer financial hardship due to an accident whilst playing or involved in a properly sanctioned game of football.

GUIDANCE NOTES

1. The scheme will be called 'The Vale of Clwyd & Conwy League Welfare scheme'
2. The treasurer of the League shall keep all records of this account.
3. Membership of the welfare scheme shall be open to any member of a club affiliated to the Vale of Clwyd & Conwy League on payment of an annual subscription fee. Clubs directly affiliated to the FAW who participate in the Vale of Clwyd & Conwy League may also become members of the scheme. Membership subscriptions must be paid through a club and cannot be paid on an individual basis.
4. The Vale of Clwyd & Conwy League will, on request, provide a claim form, on which a claim may be made. It is expected that a medical certificate will be submitted with any claim. The executive committee of the league will update the claim form as and when necessary.
5. All claims are to be made via the league general secretary and thus forwarded to the league's welfare officer.
6. Membership of the scheme will commence on receipt on the appropriate membership subscription. This should be submitted before the end of September in any playing season and will continue until the last day of that season, and shall include any correctly granted extension to the season plus any properly sanctioned friendly matches.
7. The executive committee of the league shall decide the membership subscription annually and the subscription fee will be communicated to all club secretaries. The current membership fee shall be 50p per person and clubs will be expected to pay this as part of a player's registration fee with the exception of those players whose clubs are directly affiliated to the FAW whereby membership fees will be paid by at £20 per club.
8. The league's executive committee will appoint a welfare officer every season to investigate and oversee all claims.
9. A sub-committee consisting of the league Chairman, General Secretary and a nominated Officer will deliberate on all claims submitted and duly decide as to the amount of grant to be paid out by the welfare fund. Payment will be made if there are sufficient funds available and will be a one off payment.
10. The decision of the committee will be final and no member may appeal the amount of grant to any other body or court of law.
11. If a false claim is made then legal action will be taken against any person involved in the claim and the whole of any costs of any such action will be borne by the person(s) making such false claim.
12. The Vale of Clwyd & Conwy League executive committee shall have the power to alter these guidance notes as and when appropriate.

then a decision must be obtained by the taking of penalties in accordance with the FA of Wales rules.

- 19 Unless otherwise mutually arranged, the Club first drawn in the ballot shall have choice of grounds. The Hon Fixture Secretary shall fix dates for the completion of ties. Any match not completed for whatever reason may be ordered to stand as a completed match, or replayed as the Executive Committee may direct. Clubs must not mutually agree to play a match in lieu of a Cup-tie.
- 20 Dates for Semi-Final ties are to be determined by the Hon Fixture Secretary. Venues are to be determined by the first team drawn out of the ballot. Dates and venues for all final ties are to be determined by the Executive Committee.
- 21 In all Final ties, the Leagues' Executive Committee will provide the match footballs.
- 22 Referees (and Assistant Referees where appointed) shall be appointed by the Referees Appointment Secretary up to and including the Semi-Finals and shall be paid a fee and travelling expenses in accordance with the scale approved by the NWCFA.
- 23 In Final ties, the match officials shall receive a memento in lieu of the match fee. They shall also be entitled to claim travelling expenses in accordance with the scale approved by the NWCFA.
- 24 The Clubs on whose ground the final ties are played shall be paid the sum of £50.00 out of the net proceeds of the gate entrance monies. The League will be responsible for the printing and publicity costs and the remaining net proceeds will be credited to the League funds.
- 25 In any Round and the Final of each Cup competition, Clubs with very similar or identical colours shall play in neutral colours, unless they can come to a mutual agreement. Any disputes will be resolved by the Executive Committee whose decision shall be final. Clubs are reminded that the Match Referee has the right to require either or both teams to change their strip if in the Referee's opinion it is necessary for the identification of opposing players.
- 26 The Laws of the Game to be observed in all competitions will be those of the FA of Wales. The Leagues' Executive Committee shall have the power to deal with any other matter not provided for under these Rules.
- 27 Ground entrance fees for the Final ties of the Cup Competitions shall be decided by the Leagues' Executive Committee.
- 28 In the Final of each Cup Competition, competing Clubs will be issued with 20 Ground Entrance passes for their players and Officials. No one will be allowed free access into the ground without an entrance pass that must be handed in to a

INFORMATION FOR CLUBS

- 9 In the case of any player being found ineligible, the Club playing him shall be adjudged to have lost the match. The Executive Committee shall also have the power to decide the cost of such hearing against the parties concerned (see League Rule 14.6.4 regarding the checking on the eligibility of a player and League Rule 20.7 regarding costs of any hearing convened).
- 10 All protests, appeals, claims and complaints must reach the Hon General Secretary within THREE days of the conclusion of the match (Sundays and Bank Holidays excluded). A fee of £25.00 must accompany all protests; if it is found on enquiry that a protest is frivolous, the Club lodging the protest, in addition to forfeiting the protest fee, may be held liable for the costs of the Executive Committee's enquiry as per League Rule 20.7. No protest regarding the playing ground, goal posts, crossbars or other appurtenances of the game shall be considered by the Leagues' Executive Committee unless it is laid down in writing with the match Referee before the commencement of the match.
- 11 Clubs may appeal to the NWCFA against any decision of the Executive Committee or Disciplinary Panel for that purpose in accordance with League Rule 20.8
- 12 The Hon Fixture Secretary for each game shall fix the conference dates.
- 13 In the case of a postponed, abandoned or replayed matches, only those players who were eligible on the original Conference date shall be allowed to play.
- 14 If at any time and because of circumstances beyond the control of the Leagues' Executive Committee, it is found not possible to play or replay a postponed or abandoned match within four weeks of the original Conference date, players registered at least SEVEN (7) days prior to the date of their replayed fixture will be eligible to play.
- 15 After TWO postponed matches of a Cup match, the Club drawn out first shall forfeit ground advantage at the discretion of the Leagues' Executive Committee.
- 16 Any Club failing to play on the day appointed by the League will be adjudged to have lost the match, unless a satisfactory explanation is given to the Leagues' Executive Committee that will allow an extension of time.
- 17 All competing Clubs shall go into the draw for the first round of all Cups. Byes shall be drawn at the discretion of the Executive or Management Committee.
- 18 The duration of Cup matches shall be 90 minutes (45 minutes each way). If a result is not obtained after 90 minutes then an extra 30 minutes (15 minutes each way) will be played. If the scores remain level after extra time has been played

All Home clubs MUST telephone the result of the match, within 30 minutes after the completion of all games, with the names and times of all goal scorers in the match of both teams (to the results number given below). It is important that the league has this information so that it can be forwarded to the press. Any club failing to adhere to this will be fined as per rule.

Please read the rule book carefully as several changes have been made

If there are changes to your club information, then please confirm this in writing as soon as possible with the General Secretary of the League.

The HOME club secretary must confirm all fixtures with the Away club and Match Referee at Least two days prior to the date of the match in writing or by telephone. (Importantly: kick-off time, venue, colours and arrangements for after match hospitality)

Match officials match fees will be Premier Division and Reserve Premier £18.00 Assistance Referees £12.00. Division's 1& 2 Match official only £16.00. This will include travelling expenses of 27p per mile up to a maximum of £27 where possible match officials will arrange to travel together at one expense.

August, September, October, all Kick-off 2:30pm November, December, January and February Kick-off 2:00pm March, April and May Kick-off 2:30pm.

Mid Week Kick-off 6:30pm unless under Floodlights Kick-off 7:30pm

Clubs are reminded that alcohol is strictly forbidden at all League & Cup matches and that Clubs are responsible for the behaviour of their players and supporters.

CLWYD FOOTBALL LEAGUE – CUP RULES.

- 1 The Clwyd Football League shall have the following Cup Competitions
 - (a) A Cup Competition solely for each Division of the League in which each team in membership thereof shall compete automatically.
 - (b) A League Cup Competition for all Non-Reserve Teams in membership.
 - (c) A League Cup Competition for all Reserve Teams in membership
- 2 The entire control and management of the Competitions shall be vested in the Executive Committee. These rules apply to all Clwyd League Cup Competitions. Should any of the Cup Competitions be sponsored, then the Sponsors' name may be incorporated into the title/name of the particular Cup Competition. The Competition shall be confined to clubs in membership of the Clwyd Football League and all players must be non-contract.
- 3 The entrance fee shall be £25.00 per competition.
- 4 The members of each team may be changed during the series of matches, but no individuals shall play for more than one competing team during the season and he must be a registered player (in accordance with League and FAW Rules) of the Club with which he proposes to play SEVEN (7) days before the conference date. For the Semi-Final and Final ties, a player must have been registered 28 consecutive days immediately prior to the date arranged for these ties.
- 5 A player shall not be allowed to play in the same Cup competition for TWO different clubs.
- 6 No club shall field in any (cup) match involving their reserve side more than THREE players, who have taken part in more than THREE League games for their senior side at one time during any game.
- 7 A player Under 18 years of age on the 1st September in the current season shall be eligible to take part in these competitions, irrespective of the number of senior matches he has played, providing the player complies with Cup Rule 4 depending on the conference date of that particular round of the competition.
- 8 If the Executive Committee or Disciplinary Panel has doubts as to the qualification of any competing player, it shall have power to call upon such player and Club to which he belongs or for which he has played, to prove to the Committee's satisfaction that he is properly qualified according to the rules, and failing such satisfactory proof to disqualify such player and remove such Club from the Competition. In accordance with the F A of Wales, only players who are at least 16 years' old are allowed to play in this Leagues' Cup Competition; which for the purpose of clarification is regarded as an 'adult league' by the FAW.

PREMIER DIVISION

26. NWCFA Child Protection.

The League is fully committed and will be governed by the current North Wales Coast Football Associations' Child Protection Policy and Code of Conduct in all cases (pages 71-74).

27. Club Minutes and account records.

Each club in membership shall keep minutes giving a true record of all resolutions adopted by its members and decisions arrived at by the Club Committee, and shall also keep account records showing in detail the items of income and expenditure. The Executive Committee shall reserve the power to call at any time, provided 48 hours notice is given, upon a club to produce before the Committee, any books, letters, documents or any other material evidence the Committee may require to examine.

28. Playing Season

- 28.1 The FAW shall determine annually the date when the playing season commences and will indicate the length of the season. These dates are to be conveyed via the North Wales Coast Football Association to all clubs on the season's first fixture list.
- 28.2 The start date of the football season shall be decided at the AGM, or adjournment thereof, of the League in accordance with (a) above.

29. Welfare Scheme

The league shall run a welfare scheme in which the purpose shall be to assist those who suffer financial hardship due to an accident whilst playing or involved in a properly sanctioned game of football. The membership fee will be 50 pence per member per season for those players who register through the Clwyd Football League and this may be altered as and when the executive committee sees fit. Players whose clubs are directly affiliated to the FAW and therefore register directly to the FAW will be eligible to become members and each club shall pay a sum of £20. (see guideline notes)

30. North Wales Reserve Premier League

- 30.1 Only clubs in membership of a directly affiliated league at level three or above can be eligible for membership.
- 30.2 All clubs in membership must play their home league and cup fixtures at the same ground as their senior side, unless in special circumstances permission is given to use an alternative venue of similar standard by the league.

22. Claims

All claims against the League by any club must be submitted in detail before the 31st May in each year, similarly, by any club against any other club in the League via the Hon General Secretary.

23. Failure to pay fines and/or reply to correspondence.

Any club that is fined for breach of the rules must pay the said fine within a period of TEN days from the date of the letter informing them of the fine. A club failing to reply to other written correspondence from the Leagues' Executive Committee/ General Secretary within TEN days will be fined the sum of £20.00

- 23.1 Clubs/Club Officials/Players who are in monetary debt to the league or, are responsible for such monetary debt, will not be allowed to participate in any aspect of football within the jurisdiction of the Clwyd Football League until such debt is honoured in full and, to the satisfaction of the league's executive committee'.

A breach of this rule will constitute a fine not exceeding £50.00

24. Guarantee for the safe custody of League Trophies.

- 24.1 A guarantee for the safe custody of any cup won by a club shall be given, by the club winning the same and such guarantee shall be a personal one of such members of the Clubs Committee as shall be in office at the time the Cup was won. In the vent of such guarantee not having been given, then such shall be implied, under these rules, as being binding, against such Committee members in the following amounts; for loss or damage to such Cup or Cups for the loss of £250.00; for damage to, the same such amount, as will thoroughly repair and make good such damage.

- 24.2 Clubs are strictly prohibited from placing any inscription upon the Cup or Cups they may hold under a very severe penalty assessed under the foregoing rule, or the sum of £100.00, whichever the Executive Committee may decide.

- 24.3 All trophies belonging to the League must be returned to the Chairman or Hon General Secretary by not later than the 1st March in every year.

25. Insurance.

It shall be compulsory for every club/team in membership of the league to insure their players and officials via the league's designated insurance company, the fee of which shall be adjusted and set annually as per premium. The premium set shall be paid together with the clubs affiliation fee on or before the AGM of the Clwyd Football League in order for cover to commence as at 1st, August of each playing season.

This rule shall not apply to clubs directly affiliated to the Football Association of Wales.

- 20.4 Where a club or player(s) elects to have a personal hearing as provided for in League Rule 7.8, the appointed Panel will conduct its business in accordance with the provisions as set out in the NWCFA Memorandum on Procedure at Personal Hearings.
- 20.5 In the case of a protest, appeal, claim or complaint, the Panel, shall have the power to grant or deny the protest, appeal, claim or complaint (in whole or in part) as well as the power to order any such penalty or sanction as the Panel shall reasonably deem fit.
- 20.6 In the case of a charge of an alleged breach of a League rule being found proven, the Panel shall have the power to order any such penalty or sanction as the Panel shall reasonably deem fit.
- 20.7 In all matters, the Panel shall have the discretion to impose a costs order against any of the parties involved.
- 20.8 If dissatisfied with any decision given by the Executive Committee or a Sub-Committee or Panel appointed by the Executive Committee, a club or player shall have the right of appeal to the North Wales Coast Football Association. Any such appeal must be lodged within TEN (10) days as of the earlier (a) the decision being announced at the time of the hearing/meeting or (b) the date of the correspondence containing the decision. All appeals must be accompanied with the appropriate fee as set out under NWCFA Rule 19.1 to 19.14 inclusive and be made payable to the NWCFA and sent to the General Secretary of the Association.

21. Player Suspension due to Bad Disciplinary Record.

- 21.1 The Executive Committee shall have the right to reprimand any Club as to the conduct of its players and/or spectators.
- 21.2 If a player persistently infringes the Laws of the Game resulting in suspensions and/or fines imposed by the NWCFA, the League will call such player to explain himself before a Disciplinary Panel hearing of the League. Should the player's behaviour subsequent to the hearing not improve; the League will request the Club, for whom the players is registered, to cancel his registration with the Club.
- 21.3 If the above fails to produce a positive result, both the Club and player will be charged with bringing the game into disrepute, and the Club, if found guilty will be fined a minimum sum of £100.00 and run the risk of being expelled from the League.

19.5 Clubs intending to resign from the League must do so in writing on or before 30th April in each year. Failure to do so, the Club(s) concerned will be fined the sum of £75.00 and will forfeit their deposit.

19.6 The League Executive Committee will exercise its discretionary powers to deal with those Clubs or Teams resigning from the League and who fail to pay any outstanding monies owing to the League. The League will place a restriction upon the registered players who were registered at the time including the Committee members at the time, until such time, that the outstanding monies are paid to the League. The amount of monies, if not paid, will be divided between those players registered and those Committee members at the time of the resignation. In addition, neither player(s) nor Committee member(s) will be accepted into the League, until either the full amount is paid or that player(s) or Committee member(s) concerned pays their proportionate amount.

19.7 Any Club/Team who resigns from the Premier Division during the season will not be allowed to re-enter the Premier Division for a period of three seasons. If they re-join the League, they must compete, initially in the lowest division.

19.8 A Club relegated from a more Senior League shall automatically be accepted into membership as the FAW's Pyramid Guidelines and Regulations.

20. Misconduct, Charges, Protest & Appeals.

20.1 All protests, appeals, claims or complaints must be sent to the Hon General Secretary and be accompanied with a fee of £25.00 that will be forfeited in the event of a protest, appeal, claim or complaint not being upheld. All such matters relating to a particular match must be lodged with the Hon General Secretary within THREE days of the match in question (Sundays and Bank Holidays excluded).

20.2 All questions regarding eligibility, qualification of players or interpretation of the rules of the League shall be decided by the Executive Committee but no objection relative to the dimensions of the ground, goal posts, crossbars or other appurtenances of the game shall be entertained unless a written protest is lodged with the match Referee before the commencement of the game. Where there is evidence of a breach of the League's rules by a club or player, the League will investigate the matter, and when considered appropriate, prefer a charge of an alleged breach of rule against the club or player(s) concerned.

20.3 The Executive Committee will appoint a Panel of THREE persons, one of whom shall be appointed as Chairman of the Panel, elected from members of the Executive Committee (excluding the Hon General Secretary), to consider all protests, appeals, claims or complaints lodged by a club or player(s) as well as all charges preferred by the League of an alleged breach of rule.

RESERVE COMBINATION LEAGUE

16. Annual General Meeting.

The Annual Meeting of the League shall be held during the month of June or July for the purpose of receiving the Treasurers Statement of Accounts, consideration of such amendments to the rules, as may have been properly notified, in accordance with League Rule 15.7, the Election of Officers and Management Committee, in accord with rule and such other business, which the Executive Committee consider it competent, under the rules to transact, but all business to be brought before the Meeting shall appear upon the Agenda, circulated to all member clubs and under no circumstances, shall any business, not so notified be transacted.

17. Annual Statement of Accounts & General Payment of Accounts.

- 17.1 The Annual Report and Balance Sheet, duly audited, shall be forwarded to each club, at least SEVEN (7) days before the date of the Annual Meeting. A copy of such balance sheets must be forwarded, within SEVEN (7) days of the Annual Meeting to the General Secretaries of the Football Association of Wales and the North Wales Coast Football Association.
- 17.2 Prior to payment, all due accounts shall be passed by the Officers and a detailed account submitted to the next available meeting of the Executive Committee of all such payments.
- ### 18. Admission to grounds.
- All members and officials of the Executive Committee shall have free access to any part of the ground, during any League or Cup game, on production of their current season badge of office, or such proof of membership, satisfactory to the home club.
- ### 19. Application for Membership to the League & Resignations.
- 19.1 No application for admission to the League shall be valid, if received after the last Executive Committee meeting, before the Annual General Meeting, or such date as the last Executive Committee meeting, before the AGM shall determine.
- 19.2 If a club is accepted into the League at the AGM, then its annual subscriptions will be in line with Rule 5.1 to 5.5 inclusive.
- 19.3 A Club may be accepted into the League if its ground and changing rooms/ facilities are acceptable to the League's Executive Committee, and has received a clear majority of not less than two-thirds of Clubs in membership of the League.
- 19.4 It is possible for a Club to be accepted into the League at the AGM only to be subsequently rejected, if its ground and/or facilities fail an inspection by officers of the League prior to the commencement of the football season.

15. League Rules

- 15.1 The Executive Committee shall have the power to deal with any matter or any infringement of the League rules not provided for under these rules and to decide the appropriate penalty for any offences not dealt with specifically under these rules.
- 15.2 No alteration of or addition to these rules, shall be made, at the Annual meeting or such adjournment thereof, or at a Special General Meeting, convened for that purpose.
- 15.3 No Special Meeting shall be convened unless a requisition is received, signed by not less than two-thirds of the clubs in membership and such requisition shall contain the full nature of any suggested alteration or amendment to the rule or rules contemplated.
- 15.4 Upon receipt of any requisition under this rule, the Hon General Secretary shall call the necessary Special Meeting, by giving each club in membership at least SEVEN (7) days notice of the time and place of such meeting and such notice shall fully describe the nature of any alteration or amendment to the rule or rules, and no deviation there from shall be allowed at the meeting.
- 15.5 Before any alteration or amendment to the rule or rules under discussion shall be declared carried, at least two-thirds of those present at the meeting, entitled to vote, shall record their votes, for such alteration or amendment.
- 15.6 All correspondence to the League both verbally and in writing from the Clubs must be from the Club Secretary to the Leagues' Hon General Secretary
- 15.7 The same proceedings shall apply to the AGM, save, that all suggested alterations must reach the Hon General Secretary, on or before the 31st day of March in each year.

14.9.2 The approaching club or person shall not give notice of intention to approach more than one player of a club at the same given time and shall not give notice of intention to approach another player of the same club until TWENTY ONE (21) days has elapsed after a prior transfer or notice. Except with the written consent of the club a minimum of TWENTY ONE (21) days notice is necessary if the first approach is made by the player, but this consent shall not be unreasonably withheld where there are circumstances of a special character exist e.g. change of residence or non selection for any team of the club for three consecutive weeks.

14.9.3 Any member club or agent of such club being found and proved guilty of irregularly approaching a player already registered will be dealt with by the Executive Committee.

14.10 No player will be permitted to transfer to another club within the League until a period of 28 days has elapsed from the registration date.

14.11 After the last Thursday in March of each season, registrations and transfers will not be permitted.

14.12 A Club may at its discretion use THREE substitute players at any time except to replace a player or players that have been suspended from the game by the Referee. Clubs may nominate up to FIVE substitute players, but only THREE shall be permitted to participate in the match. Substitutions can only be made when play has been stopped for any reason and the Referee has given permission. The name(s) and number(s) of the substitutes must be nominated to the Referee and agree with the team sheet and team lists submitted to the opponents and the Referee.

14.13 No player having taken part in matches for a Club shall be allowed to join another Club without first satisfying the officials of his existing Club and intended Club that he has discharged his reasonable financial and other liability to the Club or Clubs for which he is, or was, a playing member. It is the responsibility of the existing Club to maintain records, mutually confirmed by Club and player, outlining any such liabilities.

14.14 Any Club or players offering or receiving any inducement to, or for, another club to win, draw or lose a match shall be guilty of serious misconduct and will be dealt with, as the Executive Committee shall decide.

- 14.6.6 Should any club wish to register a player where International Clearance is necessary, and then the club concerned must obtain that International Clearance before the registration is offered to the League for processing. All clubs must familiarise themselves with the FAW regulations regarding International Clearance. A copy of the International Transfer Certificate must be forwarded with the Registration form to the Hon Registration Secretary of the Clwyd Football League once it has been received from the Football Association of Wales.
- 14.7 In the event of a player signing registration forms for more than one club in the League, priority of registration shall be the deciding factor. The Club submitting the latter form will be notified of the fact and the Executive Committee shall investigate the matter. Any player found to have wilfully signed registration forms for more than one club in the League or if a club is found to have knowingly induced a registered player of another club to sign a registration form will be dealt with by the Executive Committee in such a manner as it shall think fit.
- 14.8 Permission for the transfer of any player must be obtained from the club holding the player's registration on the authorised forms, such transfer to be valid when the club requesting the transfer receives the certification of the transfer. The club holding the player's registration within 48 hours of receipt of application for such transfer must complete all transfer forms. The appropriate fee shall be payable to the League and must accompany the transfer request.
Football Association of Wales Form J4 must be used at all times when transferring players from all other Leagues.
- 14.9 All Clubs must note FAW Rule, Item H, on contracts and transfers.
- 14.9.1 A player who does not hold a written contract with his club shall not be approached, except during the period of 'Close Season' by any Club or person attempting to induce such player to play for another club or clubs without at least SEVEN (7) days notice in writing to the Secretary of the Club for which the player was last known to have played and the negotiations with the player must cease at the expiration of FOURTEEN (14) days from the day of such notice being given. A copy of any notification shall also be sent to the Leagues' Hon Registration Secretary of its actions in writing. The notice must be forwarded by recorded delivery, registered post or a written acknowledgment otherwise obtained. A second notice shall not be given by the same club in respect of the same player during the same football season.

(iii) whether registered for a club that is a member of a League playing at National Level or a League playing at Recreational Level, a player may be registered for a maximum of THREE (3) clubs during the period 1st June to 31st May of the following year and during such period the Player will only be eligible to play for TWO (2) clubs PROVIDED THAT if a player registers for a second club pursuant to the exceptions permitted in League Rules 14.6.2 (i) or 14.6.2 (ii). In either case, such second registration shall not count towards the total THREE (3) registered clubs and playing for such second club shall not count towards the total of playing for TWO (2) clubs.

14.6.3 Types of Registration Forms applicable are;

- J1 - Contract Registration for FAW.
- J2 - Transfer of registration of a non-contract player between clubs in different Leagues.
- J3 - Non-Contract player registration form.
- J4 - Transfer of registration of a player between clubs in the same League.
- J5 - Contract Registration for the League

The J2 Form is compulsory for all Leagues within Wales.

14.6.4 There shall be no requirement for a cancellation of a player's registration during the registration period as in future a player must only be transferred to a new club at all times. The registration and transfer of non-contract players will be on forms supplied by the League at a cost of £1.00 per form, the registration of all players will be valid for ONE season only.

14.6.5 A bona-fide player of a club is one who has signed the appropriate League Registration form and who has been registered and approved by the Leagues' Hon Registration Secretary before 5:00pm on the day immediately preceding the game. Facsimile registrations are permitted in order to comply with the 5:00pm deadline; however, the actual registration/transfer form must then be submitted by the first available post.

It is the responsibility of each club at all times to ensure that players have been properly registered with the Hon Registration Secretary prior to playing in any arranged fixture subject to the Leagues' Rules.

The Executive Committee has the power to refuse and cancel the registration of any player found guilty of undesirable conduct and to disqualify the player in question from participating in any or all games in the League. If such action is taken, then the NWCFA must be notified.

No emergency registration endorsed by the Referee prior to a game will be permitted.

13.24 Should the HOME club, in very exceptional circumstances be unable to comply with League Rule 13.23, the sanction of the Hon Fixture Secretary must be received before a club is empowered to postpone the match.

14. **Player(s) Registration & Transfers.**

- 14.1 Duplicated or photocopied forms will not be accepted for the purpose of registering players.
- 14.2 All Registrations for a Club playing at Recreational level (below Directly affiliated Leagues) shall be from 1st June until the last Thursday in March inclusive.
- 14.3 A player aged fifteen years of age at the commencement of the season will not be permitted to register for a senior club until he has obtained the age of 16 in accordance with the criteria as currently determined by the Football Association of Wales.
- 14.4 Any club playing an ineligible player or players may have THREE (3) points deducted from their record and be liable to a fine not exceeding £100.00 and/or otherwise dealt with by the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee may at its discretion, order a match to be replayed.
- 14.5 A player without a written contract may not be placed on the ‘open to transfer’ list and no sum shall be paid or received by a club for the transfer of any such player unless he signs a written contract.
- 14.6.1 All players must be contract or non-contract players. The Football Association of Wales rules will apply to the signing and transfer of contract players. They will be registered on Form J supplied by the Football Association of Wales and Transfer of any said player will be on Form L.
- 14.6.2 Whether registered for a Club that plays in a League at National Level or that plays at Recreational Level, a player not holding a written contract with their club may only be registered for ONE club at a time PROVIDED THAT this shall not prevent: -
- (i) a youth player being registered with separate clubs to play youth and adult football in circumstances permitted in Rule 14.3 (see above); or
 - (ii) a player also being registered with another club that is not a member and that only plays Association Football on a Sunday.

- 13.17 The Referee must inform any defaulting clubs, before the start of the match, of his intention to report any late start.
- 13.18 The Referee shall also advise the Hon General Secretary of any report he will be submitting to the Disciplinary Secretary of the NWCFA in the case of any misconduct by a player or spectator etc.
- 13.19 Referee who are the cause of late starts will be fined 50p per minute (minimum £2.50) and reported to the NWCFA unless the Executive Committee, after considering the report or evidence, is satisfied the delay was unavoidable.
- 13.20 The HOME Club will be responsible for the Referees travelling expenses according to a scale approved by the NWCFA, plus half fee, where the match was postponed or abandoned, after he had duly inspected the ground as per rule 8.4. But where the match is abandoned for any other reason, then the whole fee plus travelling costs becomes payable subject to the decision of the Executive Committee.
- 13.21 In all cases, where players are ordered off by a Referee or where the Referee submits a special report on the misconduct of spectators, then the Assistant Referee, if neutral and appointed by the Referees Appointment Secretary, shall supplement his report by one of their own and forward it on to the Disciplinary Secretary of the NWCFA, the same day as the match was played.
- 13.22 No member of the Leagues' Executive Committee shall be appointed to officiate as Referee or Assistant Referee in any match, nor shall be Referee or Assistant Referee be present members of either of the competing clubs.
- 13.23 In the event of the Referee or Assistant Referee appointed not attending a match, or not being in time to commence the game, the following procedure shall obtain:
- (i) in the case of the Referee, the TWO clubs must first agree to one from amongst those present at the ground, in all cases, preference being given to a registered or qualified referee.
- (ii) in cases of the Assistant Referee, the Referee being present shall appoint such person or persons, as he shall deem competent. All such emergency officials shall be considered League officials during the period for which they officiate.
- (iii) on arrival of the permanent officials, they shall take over their duties, but a report of their late arrival shall be made by both clubs to the Hon General Secretary who in turn will report to the Executive Committee and who shall deal with the whole circumstance connected with that match and decide the best course of action.

- 13.8 Where neutral Assistant Referees are appointed by the Executive Committee, then such Assistant Referees shall be paid a match fee and travelling expenses in accordance with the scale approved by the NWCFA and with the same conditions of travelling as applies to the Referee.
- 13.9 Any Club found guilty of paying either the Referee and/or Assistant Referee more than the scale fees shall be deemed guilty of misconduct and shall be dealt with, as the Executive Committee shall decide. The Referee and/or Assistant Referee found accepting such enhanced fees shall also be dealt with for serious misconduct and be debarred from future appointments within the League, fined otherwise, dealt with as the Executive Committee shall decide and reported to the NWCFA.
- 13.10 The Referee shall have power to decide as to the fitness of the ground for play.
- 13.11 Each Club must take every precaution to keeping its ground in a playing condition, and if necessary, the HOME club may require a Referee to visit the ground for the purpose of making the necessary inspection at least FOUR (4) hours before the advertised time of kick-off.
- 13.12 Should the Referee, after due inspection, be of the opinion that the ground will not be in a fit condition to play upon, he must inform an official of the HOME Club and contact the Hon Fixture Secretary immediately he has completed his inspection.
- 13.13 The HOME club official being informed MUST communicate the same to the visiting club immediately, in time to prevent their travelling or failing which immediately the visiting team arrives at the dressing room.
- 13.14 On the match being postponed by a Referee, the HOME Club official must also contact the Hon Fixture Secretary to inform him. Clubs failing to comply with this rule will be fined the sum of £10.00.
- 13.15 Should the HOME clubs ground not be private and the ground is declared unfit by the landlords grounds man, the HOME club shall be responsible for ensuring that a written report is forwarded by post or by electronic mail to the Hon Fixture Secretary, to be received no later than FOUR (4) days (Sundays excluded) after the inspection has taken place. Clubs failing to comply with this rule will be fined the sum of £10.00.
- 13.16 The Referee shall within FOUR (4) days (Sundays excluded) forward a report to the Hon General Secretary, the result of the match, circumstances whereby it was postponed or abandoned (from whatever cause), late starts and late arrival of any official or player.

- 12.2 Any club found guilty of either falsifying or submitting an incorrect team sheet or match result form will be liable to a fine not exceeding the sum of £50.00.
- 12.3 The HOME Club must also provide the Referee with a copy of the team sheet upon a form supplied by the League that must include the full list of players including all named substitutes together with an addressed envelope, as supplied by the League, together with a stamp or cash equivalent, enabling the form to be forwarded to the Hon General Secretary. Failure to register the names of players and/or substitutes on the form provided, prior to the commencement of the match will result in the Referee having the right to refuse any such player and/or substitute from participating in the match. The competing teams must exchange team sheets prior to the commencement of the match. Failing to comply with any aspect of this rule, the guilty club will be fined the sum not exceeding £25.00.
- 12.4 The HOME club must telephone the result of their match on the day to the Clwyd League within 30 minutes after the final whistle. Failure to do so will result in a fine of £20.00.
- 12.5 ALL Clubs must also mark the Match Referee between 5-10 on the same form provided for by the League for every match as per rule 12.1. Any club allocating a minimum mark of 5 must also provide a letter of explanation as to why such a mark is given. Clubs failing to comply with any part of this rule will be liable to a fine of £10.00
13. **Referees and Assistant Referees.**
- 13.1 Only properly registered and qualified Referees and Assistant Referees shall be appointed.
- 13.2 Referees and/or Assistant Referees failing to fulfil their appointed fixture may be fined equivalent to their respective match fee and reported to the NWCFA unless a satisfactory explanation is received.
- 13.3 Referees are expected to arrive at the ground at least 30 minutes prior to the kick-off time.
- 13.4 Clubs are expected to have the Referees changing facilities open at this time.
- 13.5 Separate accommodation must be provided for the match official(s).
- 13.6 Premier Division clubs must also be able to accommodate neutral Assistant Referees, if appointed by the Referees Appointments Secretary.
- 13.7 The HOME club shall pay the Referee (and Assistant Referee, when appointed), a match fee and travelling expenses, according to scale as approved by the NWCFA.

10.2 Clubs seeking membership of the League shall have their grounds inspected by the Executive Committee. Each Club accepted into membership of the League must have its registered League ground available for matches at all times, those matches being next in order of precedence to the competition under the auspices of the FA of Wales, the NWCFA, the Welsh Premier League, the Cymru Alliance League and the Welsh Alliance League.

10.3 The grounds of all League clubs may be inspected at any time by order of the Executive Committee, and they may also order such improvements to the ground as they may consider necessary, such being within the just means of the club concerned.

10.4 Clubs seeking promotion to the Premier Division must have a ground that complies with the League's ground criteria. Clubs in breach of the criteria will be fined a sum not exceeding £25.00 on each and every occasion that the club does not comply with this rule.

10.5 Clubs failing to maintain the necessary standard of their ground may be excluded at the end of the season

10.6 The HOME club must ensure that its changing rooms are available to the visiting team and match officials at least 45 minutes before the appointed kick-off time.

11. Champion Club

11.1 At the end of each seasons' competition, the club in each Division scoring the largest number of points shall be declared the champion club of that Division, three points being awarded for each game won and one point for each game drawn. Should two or more clubs be equal on points, the club having the best goal difference shall be the winners. In the event of the goal difference being equal, the Club shall play off on a neutral venue, the gate money being equally divided between the competing clubs and the Leagues' Executive Committee.

11.2 The League Champions and Runners Up will be presented with 18 mementoes each from the funds of the League.

12. Results of Matches.

12.1.1 Each club shall forward to the Hon General Secretary upon a form, that will be supplied thereof, the result of the match, together with the full names and registration or transfer number of their players competing therein, indicating the names of the substitutes who participated in the match, indicating the goal scorers and a nomination of a player from the opposing team for the Player of the Year award, all within FOUR (4) days of the match (Sundays excluded). Any Club failing to complete the report correctly where required shall be fined the sum of £10.00. Failing to submit such report, each defaulting club shall be fined a separate sum of £10.00 and a further £10.00 for every SEVEN (7) days the form remains outstanding.

- 8.13 Any Club failing to keep its engagement without rendering a reason deemed satisfactory by the Executive Committee WILL have THREE (3) points deducted from their playing record and shall be fined a sum not exceeding £100.00. Clubs failing to keep its engagement must forward such a report in writing to the Hon General Secretary within FOUR (4) days (Sundays excluded) of the scheduled match. Disappointed clubs may be awarded such compensation, as the Executive Committee may deem reasonable.
- 8.14 A Club charged with the non-fulfilment of a League fixture shall under normal circumstances be given at least SEVEN (7) days notice to attend a Disciplinary Panel Hearing to defend itself. If such offence occurs near the end of the football season, it may not be possible to provide such notice to the Club. Under such circumstances THREE (3) days notice will be given to the Club.
- 8.15 Clubs responsible for a late start, whether the match is completed or not, will be fined 50p per minute (minimum £2.50).
- 8.16 HOME clubs will provide such half-time refreshments, as is usual to the visiting team and Match officials. Any Club failing to provide such refreshments will be fined the sum of £20.00.

9. Club Colours

- 9.1 Each Club in the League shall register its colours with the Hon General Secretary. No Club in the same Division shall have the same colours, however, if any club(s) have at present, the same or similar colours, the HOME side shall, for any League and Cup fixture, adopt entirely different and distinctive colours to that of the Away club.
- 9.2 All Goalkeepers must adopt such another colour that will distinct him from those of either the competing teams.
- 9.3 No player, including the goalkeeper, will be permitted to wear BLACK.
- 9.4 Players must wear the shirt numbers that corresponds with his position/number given on the team sheet.
- 9.5 Clubs failing to comply with rules 9.1 to 9.4 inclusive will be liable to a fine not exceeding the sum of £25.00.

10. Grounds.

- 10.1 Each Club must take every precaution to ensure its ground is in a satisfactory playing condition at all times. Goal-nets and corner flags must be provided at all times. Clubs failing to comply with this rule will be fined the sum of £10.00.

8.5 In the event that a match is abandoned for whatever reason, BOTH clubs must send a written report to the Hon General Secretary within FOUR (4) days (Sundays excluded) as to why the match was abandoned. Clubs failing to comply with this rule will be fined the sum of £10.00.

8.6 HOME clubs must confirm the game with their opponents no later than 2 days prior to the fixture. Clubs failing to comply with this rule will be fined the sum of £10.00

8.7 HOME clubs must also confirm the match with the appointed match official no later than 2 days prior to the fixture. Clubs failing to comply with this rule will be fined the sum of £10.00 unless a reasonable written explanation is given.

8.8 Postponed matches must be sanctioned by the Hon Fixture Secretary at all times and under such terms, as he shall decide in consultation with the Executive Committee.

8.9 Kick-off times for matches throughout the season shall be determined by the Executive Committee.

Kick off times shall be as follows;

August, September and October	2:30pm.
November, December, January and February	2:00pm.
March, April and May	2:30pm.

Midweek matches will kick off at 6:30pm or 7:30pm (those with floodlights)

NOTE.

All Cup Matches will kick off 30 minutes earlier than the advertised League matches in order to allow for extra time and penalties, should they be required.

8.10 No Club shall be allowed to postpone a fixture with another club, unless it is to play a conference fixture in the FAW or NWCFA Cup Competitions, or in the event of TWO or more players being selected for a Representative game. In the event, the appropriate Club Secretary must give at least SEVEN (7) days notice in writing to the Hon General Secretary of full particulars and the inability to fulfil its League or Cup fixture so arranged by the League. No player under suspicion shall be selected to represent the League.

8.11 Each Club will be allowed no more than TWO free dates per season providing the Hon Fixture Secretary is given at least **28 days** notice of such request, **in writing.**

8.12 The Hon Fixture Secretary will endeavour to complete the League programme for all clubs by the last Saturday in April in each season.

- 7.4 Any infringement of the League rules shall be dealt with in such manner as the Executive Committee thinks fit.
- 7.5 In the event of any voting at any meeting being equal, the Chairman of such meeting shall have a casting (second) vote.
- 7.6 Both the Executive and Management Committees shall meet when necessary.
- 7.7 The Hon General Secretary shall give at least SEVEN (7) days notification to Clubs and Members of the League by post or electronic mail of the date, venue and starting time of such meeting
- 7.8 A member club or player ordered by the League to provide a written response to a charge preferred by the League, or a protest, appeal, claim or complaint lodged with the League by a club or player, must do so within TEN days of the date of the letter from the League requesting the written response. Such written response must stipulate whether or not the Club requires a personal hearing. Should a Club or player fail to provide a written response within the stipulated ten days, they will be deemed to have denied the charge of misconduct or allegations contained in the protest, appeal, claim or complaint lodged and the League will take the required steps to convene a hearing at which the Club or player will be required to attend.
- 8. Fixtures.**
- 8.1 All matches shall be arranged on a system to be decided upon the Hon Fixture Secretary on behalf of the Executive Committee, so as not to clash with the Conference dates of the Football Association of Wales and the North Wales Coast Football Association Cup Competitions.
- 8.2 Each club must play its full strength team in all League & Cup matches or be dealt with by the Executive Committee in accordance with the League rules.
- 8.3 All matches shall be played under the Laws of the Game as per FA of Wales regulations and shall be of 90 minutes duration (45 minutes each way). Clubs shall not mutually agree to play a match in lieu of any League match.
- 8.4 Any match **not completed** may be ordered to stand as a completed match, or replayed for the full period of 90 minutes as the Executive Committee may direct. In the event of a match being ordered to be replayed, the Executive Committee shall decide on how the expenses of the replayed match is to be shared. In the event of play being stopped because of the weather, the match referee must wait a reasonable length of time (maximum 30 minutes) before deciding to abandon the match.

CLWYD FOOTBALL LEAGUE. League & Cup Rules.

1. Name & Constitution.

This amalgamation of Clubs shall be called the 'Vale of Clwyd & Conwy Football League. However, should the League be supported by a sponsor, then the name of the sponsor may be incorporated into the title of the League.

2. League Structure.

- 2.1 The League shall comprise of as many Divisions dependant on its membership but no division shall contain more than 16 teams in each division. However, the League's Executive Committee shall have the power to decide on how many teams shall participate in each division and decide whether to establish as many Divisions so as to absorb Senior, Reserve & Junior Clubs from within the area. It shall not be permissible for one club to have TWO teams playing in the same Division.
- 2.2 The League's Executive Committee in accordance with the Football Association of Wales' Pyramid Guideline and Regulations will determine the promotion and relegation of teams between the respective divisions.

3. Executive & Management Committee.

- 3.1 The League shall be governed by an Executive Committee that shall have full responsibility for managing the League.
- 3.1.2 The following Executive Committee posts shall be filled by a ballot of League members (if necessary), on an annual basis, at the Annual General Meeting (AGM) or adjournment thereof, of the League, (see League Rule 16);
- Patron, President, Vice-Presidents (maximum 4), Hon Chairperson, Hon Vice-Chairperson, Hon General Secretary, Hon Treasurer, Hon Fixture Secretary & Hon Registration Secretary.
- 3.1.3 The member clubs shall also elect ONE member from each Division within the League, annually at the AGM, and who will automatically be considered part of the Executive Committee.
- 3.1.4 All post holders covered by rules 3.1.2, 3.1.3, 3.2, 3.3, 3.4 and 3.5 shall also be considered members of the League's Management Committee.
- 3.2 Each club is entitled to send no more than TWO representatives to the League Management Committee meetings and to any type of General Meeting of the League, however; only ONE representative will be allowed to vote. Any club failing to attend any meeting of the League's Management Committee without a written explanation to the Hon. General Secretary will be fined the sum of £25.00.

- 3.3. An appointed Representative from the NWCFA will be invited to attend any League Management Committee or General Meeting of the League.
- 3.4. Life Members shall automatically become members of the League Executive Committee without having to be elected annually into this position as per Rule 3.1.2
- 3.5. Hon Vice-Presidents and representatives from the Rhyl & District Referees Association and Clwyd Area Referees Association will also be invited to attend any League Management Committee or General Meeting of the League.
- 3.6. Club Members at rule 3.2 above shall, at the AGM or adjournment thereof, elect a new Club(s) into the League, by a clear majority of not less than two-thirds of Clubs in membership of the League (see also League Rule 19).
- 3.7. Post holders at 3.1 to 3.4 inclusive shall have full voting powers at either the Executive Committee or League Management Committee meetings and also at the AGM or adjournment thereof.
- 3.8. Post holders covered by rule 3.5 will not be allowed to vote on any issue although they will be allowed to air their views and make suggestions.
- 3.9. Members of the League covered by rules 3.1 to 3.5 inclusive and who have rendered extra meritorious or at least 15 years' service to football in the area and retiring Presidents and Chairpersons, may be elected as Life Members of the League at the AGM or adjournment thereof, and shall have full voting powers.
- 3.10. Only those post holders covered by rules 3.1.2, 3.1.3 and 3.4 shall be eligible to be members of any ad-hoc committees of the League.
- 3.11. In the event of a vacant post, the Executive Committee shall have the power to fill such vacancy.

4. Auditors.

An auditor will be appointed annually at the AGM of the League and who shall be responsible for the due audit of accounts annually for presentation to each member clubs at least SEVEN (7) days prior to the AGM.

5. Club Annual Subscriptions.

- 5.1. Clubs in membership of the League shall pay an annual subscription determined and approved by the League's Executive Committee (excluding entry fees for all domestic League Cup Competitions) that must be paid on or before the date of the AGM.

- 5.2. Clubs failing to adhere to League rule 5.1 will incur a fine of £10.00 and will not be entitled to vote at the AGM or any further meeting until such time the subscriptions are paid in full.
- 5.3. A Club withdrawing from the League before the end of the Season shall forfeit its subscription and cup entrance fees. The Executive Committee shall investigate the matter and such Club may be fined a minimum sum of £25.00 for each non-fulfilment of fixture.
- 5.4. Clubs shall also pay a sum of £100.00 by way of a deposit or guarantee that the club will duly perform and keep its full obligations to the League in accordance with the rules in force. All deposits shall be placed to the credit of each club in a separate deposit account and will be returned to any club upon full compliance of this rule.
- 5.5. All other monies received by the officers of the League shall be placed to the League's credit at a bank selected by the Executive Committee and in the name of the League. Withdrawals on behalf of the League shall only be made by cheque on the signature of any TWO of the following; Chairman, Treasurer and General Secretary for the time being, who shall also be the trustees for and on behalf of the Executive Committee together with all assets, cups, monies and any other property that may hereafter come into the possession of the League.

6. Objectionable Conduct by Clubs.

At the AGM or an EGM called for that purpose, it shall be competent for a majority of the delegates present and voting thereat to exclude from membership any club whose conduct has, in their opinion, been objectionable. Before this rule can operate, all objections shall be first communicated in writing to the Hon General Secretary, who must relay such evidence to the Executive Committee who shall hear such evidence as they may consider necessary to prove (or otherwise) that a prima-facie case has been made out. Voting shall be by ballot and the club whose conduct is under consideration shall not be entitled to vote.

7. Executive & Management Committee Jurisdiction and Meetings.

- 7.1. The Executive Committee shall have jurisdiction over all matters, whether especially provided for in these rules or not, and shall have the power to appoint any Sub-Committee it may consider any may delegate all or any of its powers to any Sub-Committee. Any such delegation of power shall be duly minuted.
- 7.2. Minutes of the Executive Committee meetings and all Sub-Committee meetings shall be taken by a member nominated and the Hon General Secretary shall always keep a copy.
- 7.3. A quorum of any Executive, Management or Sub-Committee meeting shall be two-thirds of its members, unless otherwise ordered.
